WELCOME BACK!

A very warm welcome back to school and the start of another year.

If you have any concerns, please contact your child's teacher in the first instance—they will be available on the playground at the end of the school day. Mr James, our Family Support Worker, is in school every day. He will also be looking closely at our attendance this year, and following up any concerns that we may have.

BREAKFAST CLUB

Breakfast Club opens at 7.45am and the entrance & car park are on the High Street. It is open for parents/carers who need childcare before school. The cost is £3.00 per day and can be paid on ParentPay. We also operate a FREE breakfast club. If your child arrives at school between 8.30am and 8.40am, they receive a breakfast free of charge.

All children who wish to attend Breakfast Club must arrive by 8.30am at the latest. There is no need to book in advance, you can just turn up on the day, however you will need to have registered (forms available from the office

or on the website—https:// www.stonebroom.derbyshire.sch.uk/parents/ letters.)
