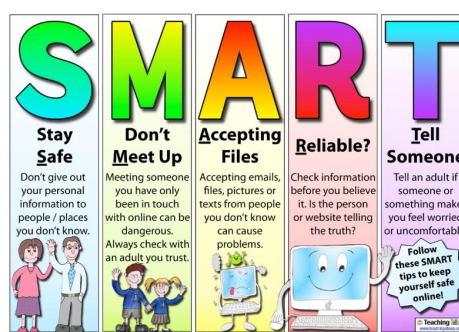
ONLINE SAFETY

GOLDEN BOOK

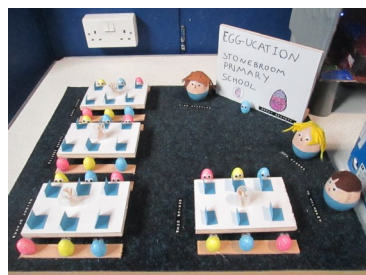

EASTER EGG COMPETITION

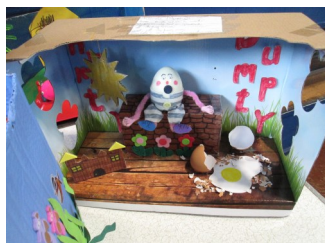
