Following our visit by Ofsted last month, we are pleased to inform you that we continue to be a good school and that the final report is now available on the school website and also on the Ofsted website.

We are particularly pleased with the report because we feel it captures the essence of our school-that pupils are proud of, and enjoy coming to school, that our pupils are positive, confident and have excellent manners and that they behave well at all times. It was recognised that pupils achieve well and are able to explain their

thinking well. Staff encourage pupils to have high aspirations and plan lessons that interest and meet the needs of all pupils. Reading is a high priority and our pupils are enthusiastic about books and reading. Maths is taught well.

We were really pleased that EYFS was recognised as giving our pupils a very good start to their education and that behaviour is exemplary in early years.

It was recognised that relationships are positive, pupils behave well, try hard and respect others.

- Our safequarding procedures are effective and we ensure that pupils are kept safe and well cared for.
- The inspector agreed with school that we need to ensure that the teaching of phonics is of a consistently high quality and to continue our work to develop our school curriculum.
