# WHAT IS HAPPENING IN SCHOOL IN JULY

We are now nearing the end of the school year-the Reception, Year 1 and Year 6 children who have returned to school have settled well and are enjoying their time in school. The staff are working hard to support these children as well as continuing to plan for those children still at home.

Although we are still living with uncertainty, we are hoping that all children can return to school as normal in September and we would very much welcome that (see next page). However it all depends on how the virus behaves now we are easing out of lockdown. School will not be open to any pupils during summer holidays.

You will be aware that the government have scrapped their plans for all children to return to school in July. In order to meet the social distancing measures that were put in place.

we are currently operating class bubbles of 8 or 9 (depending on the size of the classroom). The Year 6 children are in a bubble of 14 as they are operating in the hall. We are now using all of our classrooms for our key worker, Year 1, Year 6 and Reception bubbles and have reached capacity for the number of staff that we have available. We will not therefore be inviting any pupils back from other year groups until September. We will continue to provide home learning through Seesaw until the end of term (17th July 2020).

We continue to have a staggered start and end to the school day and also each bubble has their own break and lunch times.

Children are to come to school in their P.E. kits on P.E. day and will remain in them all day, therefore no P.E. kit in school is needed —they will be informed of their P.E. day in September. P.E. kit consists of :white tshirt, black shorts/leggings/joggers & trainers or plimsolls. Please wear school jumpers.



#### **SEPTEMBER 2020**

We are aiming to have all children back in September, government regulations permitting. More details pertinent to your child are on the letters page of the school website—<u>https://www.stonebroom.derbyshire.sch.uk/</u> parents/letters, however we ask you to be aware that the

following regulations will be in place:

- Children will be wearing school uniform—this will be our usual uniform (see previous page) with the exception of P.E. day when they should come to school in the P.E. kit (see previous page).
- Children will be in key stage bubbles—Foundation (Reception & Nursery), KS1 (Years 1&2), Lower KS2 (Years 3&4) & Upper KS2 (Years 5&6).
- There will be staggered times to the start and end of the school day for each bubble.
- Paid breakfast club will be open (£3.00 per day), however free breakfast club will not be available.
- Bagels will be available free of charge on the playground.
- There will be no tuck shop—children must bring their own snack (fruit only Mon—Thurs)
- Desks in years 1-6 will be forward facing, with children sat next to each other (not facing each other)
- There will be no parent assemblies during the autumn term.
- Reception parents will not be able to bring their children into school. The children will be collected from the courtyard.
- The school kitchen WILL be open for hot dinners.
- Year 3 children **will** still be learning to play a musical instrument every Wednesday afternoon.
- Year 5 will be swimming every Thursday afternoon although this will not start until November 2020 at the earliest.
- The only after school club in the autumn term will be Homework Club—Monday 3.30pm—4.30pm. It will be held in 3 different classrooms with 3 different teachers.
- Children will be asked to only bring essential items in from home (no toys, pencil cases etc) to reduce the risk of cross contamination and sharing.
- There will be extra tuition provided for small groups/ individuals who we believe may have been affected academically during lockdown. This will be led by Mrs Hobot.
- Mrs Attenborough (Learning Mentor), Annette Dillon (Pastoral Officer) and Elaine Wright (counsellor) are here to help support you and your children. Please contact us if you or your child would like to have a chat with them.
- School attendance WILL be compulsory—your child must come to school.
