LATEST COVID GUIDELINES

At the time of writing, the latest Government guidelines regarding testing positive for COVID are:

- Should your child test positive from a lateral flow test, they do not need to have a PCR test.
- The child should self-isolate for 5 days. If, after 5 days, your child's LFT test is negative and they have no symptoms, they can return to school. If they test positive they must continue to self-isolate for the full 10 days.
- Whilst they are self-isolating, your child will have work set on Seesaw. Should they feel well enough, they should complete the work—this means that they do not have any gaps in their education when they return to school.
- Should a different member of your household test positive, then your child must come to school as usual—we do suggest that they carry out a LFT on a daily basis.

PARENT SURVEY

Many thanks for completing our parent survey. The results were very interesting & encouraging and we will be following up some of the suggestions made.

The most positive answers with 90% and above responding that they agree were:

My child feels safe and secure at school, school is well led and managed, teaching is good at the school, the topics (Big Questions) are engaging and interesting for my child, the school website gives me all the information that I need, I know what to do if I have any concerns about my child at school, I receive clear information about forthcoming events, my child is making good progress & my child enjoys school.

Strengths of the school include: friendly staff, Forest School, it is obvious that every child is important, there is regular communication, planning on the class pages of the website is super, the excellent teaching, there are a variety of clubs & the curriculum is really engaging.

Areas to develop include: more tolerance to younger siblings during performances, smoking outside school should stop, look at introducing an after school childcare club.
