# FREE BREAKFAST CLUB

After being closed for over two years, as from Monday 25th April, our free breakfast club will once again be open. This means that ANY child (with the exception of nursery) can go to breakfast club between 8.30am and 8.40am and receive a breakfast free of charge. Once they have eaten they will either go and play in the golden room, or play outside on the MUGA or the Trim Trail until school doors open at 8.45am, when they will be taken to their class.

The entrance to Breakfast Club is through the set of gates on High Street.

Your child must be registered to attend Breakfast Club. Registration forms are available on the website (follow the link—<a href="https://www.stonebroom.derbyshire.sch.uk/parents/letters">https://www.stonebroom.derbyshire.sch.uk/parents/letters</a>) or ask at the school office.

Once registered your child can attend any day—places do not have to be booked—they can just turn up.

## **AFTER SCHOOL CLUB SURVEY**

Following the analysis of the parent questionnaire, we were asked about the possibility of opening an after school childcare club. In March we asked any parents who were interested to complete a survey so we could look at how viable (cost wise & staffing wise) opening up an after-school club would be.

Four families completed the survey, only one family were willing to pay over £2.00, with 5.30pm be-

ing the latest pick up.

Whilst we understand that an afterschool childcare facility would be helpful to some families, unfortunately, at this current time, we do not have enough interest to make it work financially.



We will survey parents and carers next year to find out if opinion/needs have changed.

## Stonebroom i-vengers Online Safety Survey Feedback March 2022

143 pupils have completed the survey with a wide range of participation throughout all year groups. The results at Stonebroom are in line with other results from the survey which encompasses Derby City and Derbyshire Primary Schools.

In light of the findings the school should concentrate efforts on reaching out to parents and carers and educating them on some of the risks that their children may be facing and what they can do at home to keep their children safer.

A couple of things stand out—they are that 54% of respondents say they go online when they are feeling lonely, 56 respondents admitting that they feel they spend too much time online and 42 respondents have had somebody they do not know trying to contact them online.

Only 51% of respondents state that they do not know how to get around parental controls set on their devices, with an additional 15% (21 pupils) admitting that there are no controls at home on their devices.

Parents need to be aware of the issues happening at home. The concern is that parents think they are keeping their children safe and take their eye off the ball, when the reality is that children are able to bypass the parental controls that are in place.

Please make sure that you know what your child is accessing online—this includes on their phone, IPad, Xbox, PlayStation etc and have parental controls in place.
