WELL it is difficult to believe that a whole year has passed and that we are nearly at the end of the 2021-22 school year. Read on to see find out what we have been up to and our plans for 2022-23.

INFORMATION FOR SEPTEMBER 2022

School reopens to pupils on Monday 5th September 2022

The start of the school day Reception Class

Children in Reception will start at 9.00am. They will line up in the courtyard at 9.00am and be collected by their class teacher—this is just for the first couple of weeks whilst they get used to the school routine.

Y1—6 8.45am—8.55am

The pupil entrance door is open **from 8.45am** to all pupils from Y1 to Y6. They simply walk into school and go into their classroom. A member of management will be stood on the main door and teaching staff will be on the school gates (this is on a rota.) A member of the class teaching team will be in the child's classroom, ready to greet them. **The register is taken at 8.55am** when all children should be in class, ready to learn.

The end of the school day

Teaching staff will bring their classes out onto the courtyard exactly as they do now.

3.10pm – Reception 3.15pm – Nursery & KS1 3.20pm – KS2

Nursery Hours

AM—8.45am—11.45am PM—12.15pm—3.15pm

Don't forget, we also do lunch club at a small cost and offer 30 hour provision.

Playground Bagels

Playground bagels will continue to be available on the playground from 8.40am—these are free of charge.

INFORMATION CONTINUED... Breakfast Club

Breakfast club starts at 7.45am and is open to any child from F2 (reception) to Y6. The children must be registered (registration forms available on the website and from the office.) The cost is £3.00 per day. If your child arrives between 8.30pm & 8.40am, they still receive a breakfast however there is no charge.

Tutoring & Catch Up Tuition

Tutoring will continue in September with the current Y5 children receiving small group tuition every morning from Mr Walmsley. Miss Hilton will carry out Catch Up Tuition with children in Y1-5.

 - 100% My child enjoys school.
 - 100% I would recommend this school to a friend

Strengths include: teamwork, leadership, well presented, clear communication, support for families, a welcoming school, the new PTA.

Areas to develop: After school club, when a date is set, keep to it, better cover for staff, option of full day nursery, less swearing from parents on the playground, no smoking outside school gates, no parking over drives right outside school.
